

And, this was my first time using Numbers, and creating spreadsheets. Search YouTube for the videos and save your money.

No depth to any of the topics. Breadth of topics covers too many apps and too many Operating Systems and therefore dilutes any given app of interest. The Apple help for these apps is better than this book and it stays up to date as well.
